

And you get to do after school clubs!

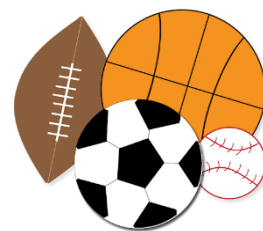
Some of your friends might be in Class Two. They are Year Ones too but they just have a different teacher! We will all do similar topics and you will still get to see your Year One friends..
