- Practise counting up to 20 and back again!
- Read lots! All sorts of exciting stories and books.
- Recap your phonic sounds, phase 2 and 3.
- (Year 2 only) Begin times table recall for 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Practise reading and writing the tricky words!

How can parents help?

5. I often get asked by parents how they can help; additional to daily reading and the homework/spellings set...
6. - For English, I always say keep recapping the phonics graphemes and start handwriting practise, letter formation is really important.
7. - For Maths, start to learn to tell the time and provide any physical practise of coins and money.
