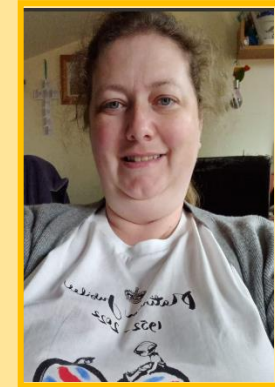

Reward System
