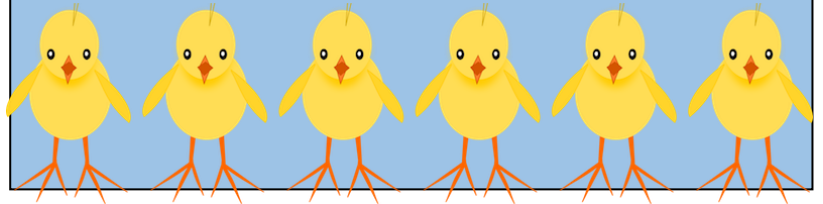
## Attention Class 2 parents: date change

## Year 2 Parents: SATs information session

As you will know, children in Year 2 take assessments as they come to the end of Key Stage 1. These are often referred to as 'SATs' and children are assessed in Reading, Writing, Mathematics and Science.

The assessments take place during the month of May. There isn't a national timetable like there is for the Year 6 tests; we tend to do them towards the end of the month, before we finish for the half term break. They are not designed to be stressful for children at all, and the children will be familiar with the layout of the booklets.

After school on **Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> March**, Year 2 parents are invited to come into school to find out more about the assessments and have a look at some examples of the kind of booklets and activities that children will be doing in May. You will also be able to see samples of children's work that is considered to be 'at the expected standard'. It will also be a chance to ask the teachers any questions you may have about the assessments.

This is a drop-in session **between 3.30 and 5pm and will take place in Class 2**. You don't need an appointment and your children are welcome to attend with you if you want to pop in straight after school. We do hope you will be able to come along and that it will be useful for you.
