The children in Class One have started preparing for their performance of 'Everyone loves a baby!'

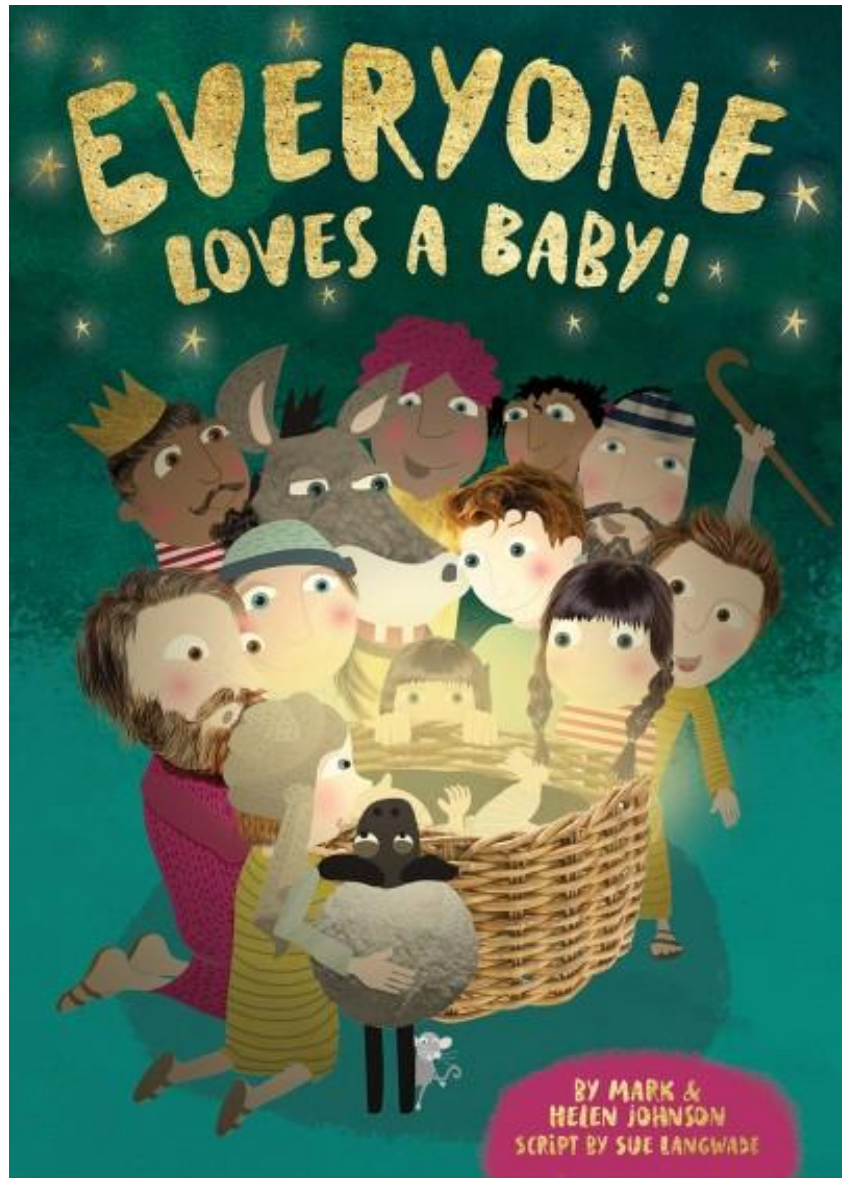
Class One Parents and relatives are warmly invited to come and watch: Thursday 12th December at 2pm. (Please do not arrive before 1.45pm)

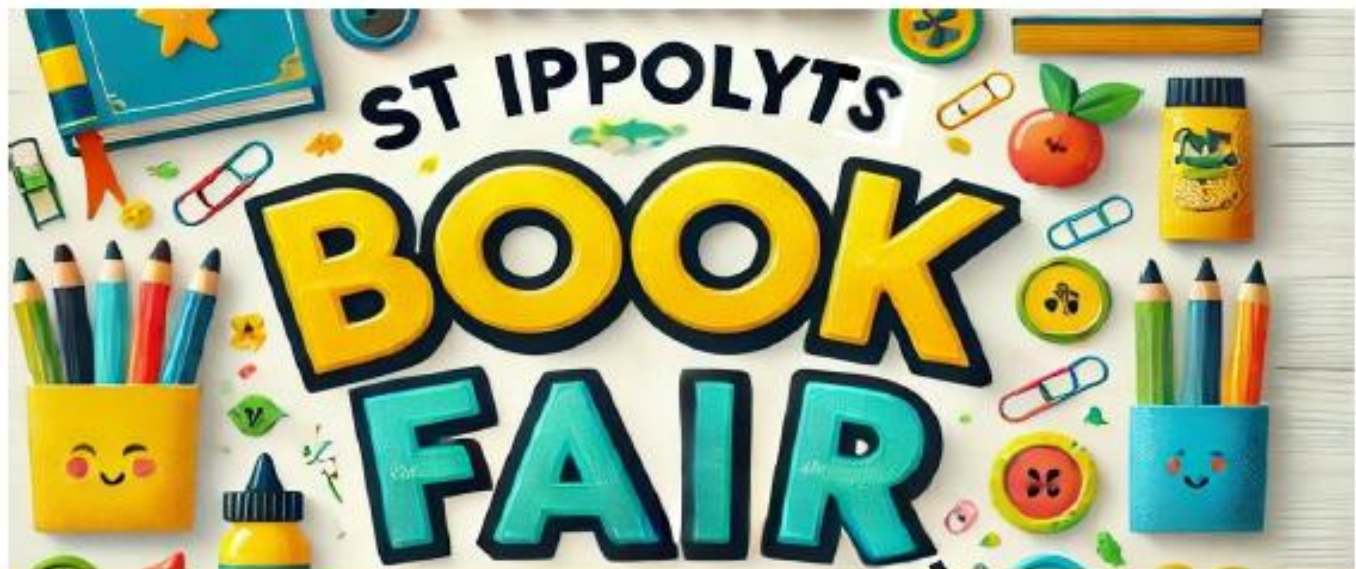
Refreshments will be served afterwards.

Once the nativity is over, you will be able to take your child home early, but not any older siblings from other classes.

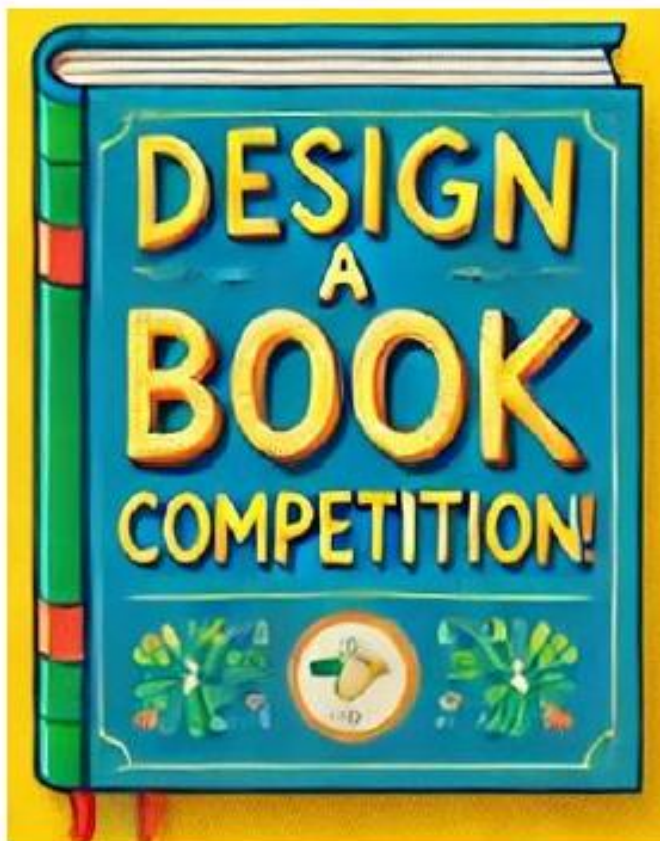
