Parents of children in Y3,4,5,6 will soon be able to book tickets for the upcoming production of Pirates of the Curry Bean via Arbor.

You will be able to book TWO TICKETS maximum.

The two tickets can be for the same performance or split over two different performances. **Please take care when booking because if you book more than two, the excess ones will be cancelled, and you won't have any say in which ones you lose.**

If you want to bring younger siblings, they can come on the Monday matinee or Tuesday morning performances (but must have a ticket allocated for seating please). The Wednesday evening performance is for adults only.

Tickets need to be booked by Wednesday 2nd July. After this date, we will release any spare tickets for families to have a 3rd ticket, so please make sure you have booked your first two by this date. There is no charge for tickets, but we will hold a collection at each performance and the PTA will also be selling refreshments.

Bookings open at 8am on Monday 23rd June 2025

If you need tickets for a particular showing, we recommend you book as early as possible as numbers are strictly capped for each performance – when they're gone, they're gone!

Raffle tickets for the Grand Draw

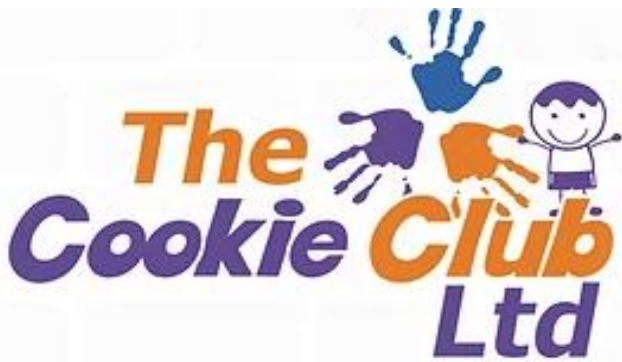
