Summer Fair Non uniform day TOMORROW!

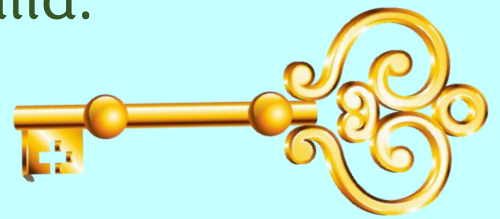
